 - Smaller 10th AF staff = 64 versus 190+
 - Many functions skip echelon to AFRC
 - Pay-It-Forward Concept
- Integrated with seven of nine lead MAJCOMs
- Continued expansion in emerging missions
 - Intelligence/Space/Cyberspace/Special Ops
 - Command and Control (Direct-COCOM Support)
 - Fifth generation aircraft (F-22, F-35)
- Continue to Broaden TFE

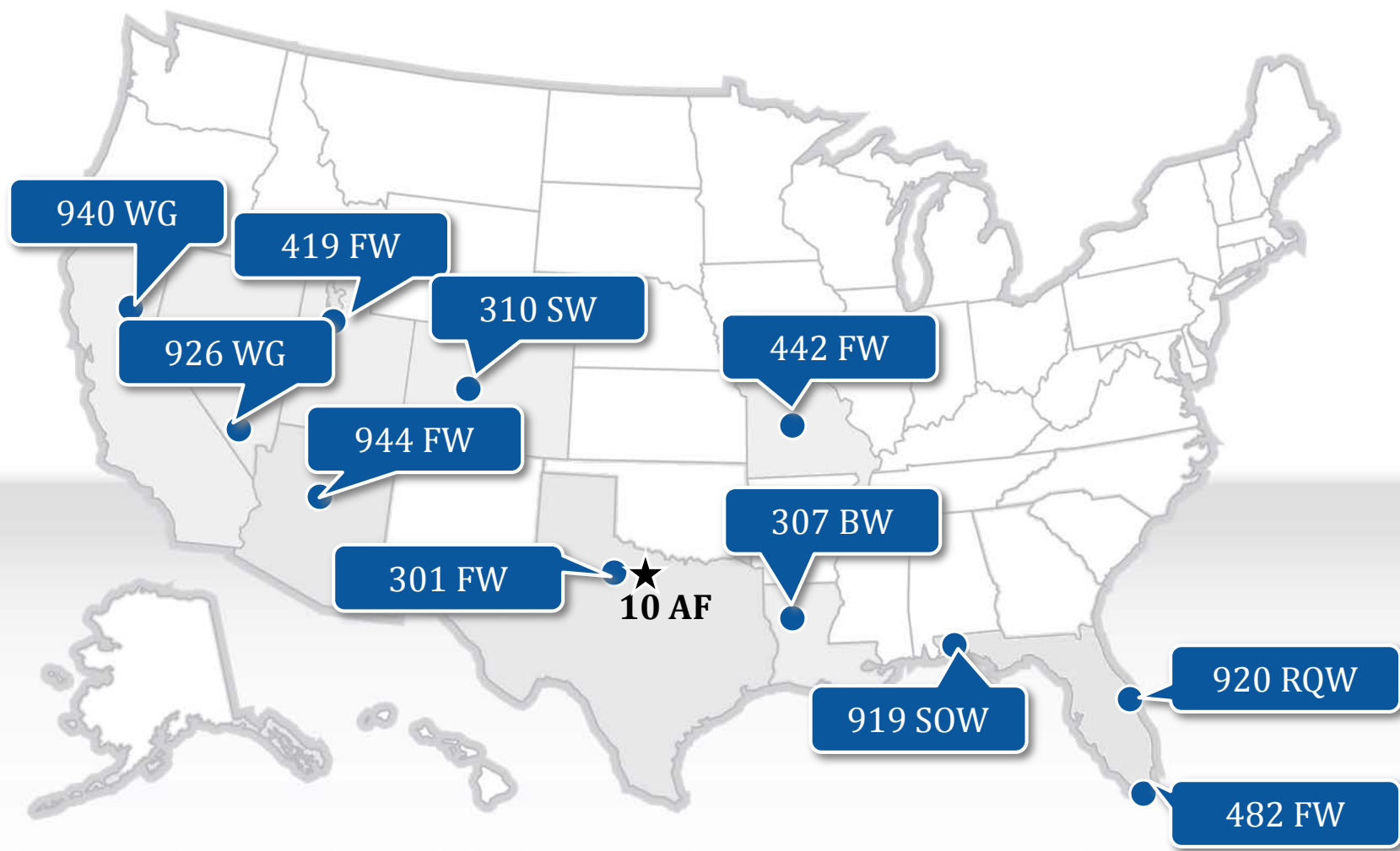

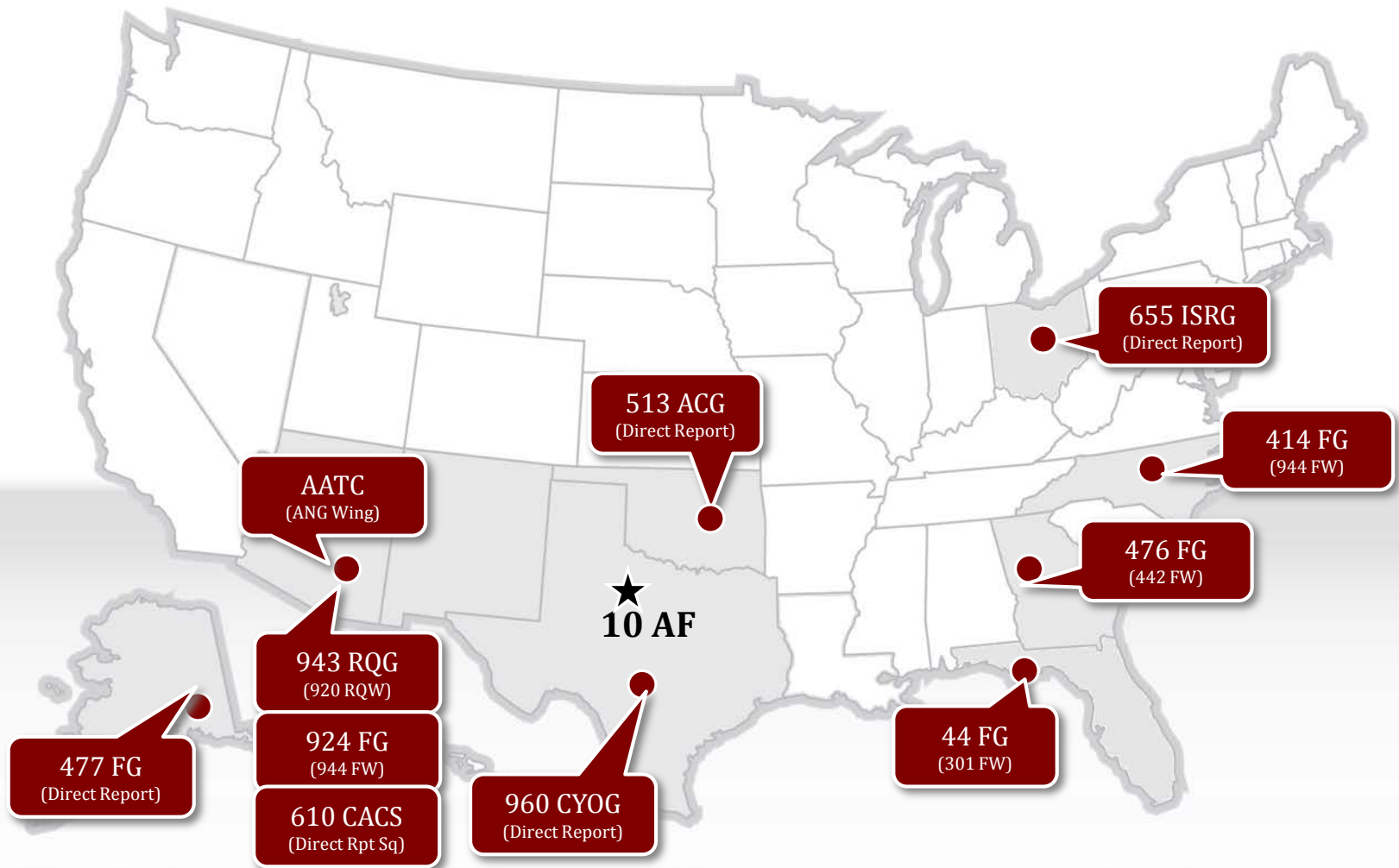

Total Force **Integration/Enterprise (TFI/TFE)**

- Maximizing resources to provide dominant combat capability in a fiscally constrained environment
 - Classic Associate
 - Active Duty maintains mission equipment for both Active and Reserve component forces
 - Active Associate
 - Reserve maintains mission equipment for both Reserve and Active component forces



TFE Advantages

- Classic

 - Reserve component leverages existing host unit processes and infrastructure (minimizing duplication)
 - Affords AFRC Airmen abundant job opportunities (mission/location)
